MEET OVERVIEW

The 2026 Masters Swimming WA State Championships will be held at the Mandurah Aquatic Centre over 2 days: Sat 11 and Sun 12 April.

The Championships will be run in Short Course 25m mode, in an outdoor pool.

For swims of 50m, 100m and 200m members can swim a maximum of 4 individual events in one day or 6 individual events over 2 days.

Members may participate in all 25m events without them counting towards their event entry limit. All individual events entered qualify for points.

Awards

- Female and Male – Swimmer of the Meet – based on FINA points
- Age Group Winners – based on individual points scored
- Clubs – Top Club, Top Country Club, Handicap (points per swimmers)

RULES AND IMPORTANT DETAILS

The meet is open to all Masters Swimmers.

- Masters Swimming Australia swim rules apply to this meet.
- Individual swim distances of 50m, 100m and 200m
 - Swimmers competing on both days (Saturday and Sunday) - may participate in a maximum of 6 individual events of 50m, 100m and 200m over two days, with a maximum of 4 individual events of 50m, 100m and 200m in one day
 - Swimmers competing on just one day (Saturday or Sunday) - may participate in a maximum of 4 individual events of 50m, 100m and 200m
- There are no restrictions on the number of individual 25m swims.
- There is no cost to enter the individual 25m swims.
- Swimmers may participate in appropriate relays.
- No refunds available.
- All participating clubs are asked to provide timekeepers. The Dolphin timekeeping system will be used. A club/lane roster will be provided in the championships program.
- It will not be possible to set World Records at this meet as there is no full Automated Officiating Equipment (AOE).



- Individual swims of 50m, 100m and 200m will be used to determine Male and Female swimmers of the meet, using the four highest FINA points scoring swims.
- Points scored from all individual swim distances will be used to determine Age Group winners. A maximum of 10 individual swims can score points.
- Points scored from all individual swim distances plus relays will be used to determine club winners.
- Members should wait up to five (5) working days after becoming financial before member details will be available for direct swimmer entry.
- Swimmers can indicate availability for relays on Saturday and Sunday when completing their individual entries.
- Club Captains are to submit relays via MSR after the close of individual entries, before the end of day on 3 April.
- Relays changes will allow substitution of swimmers, provided there is no change of Age Group.
- Refreshments will be provided after the completion of racing on Sunday 12 April.

The clubs' competition has three categories

- **Top Club** – club with the most points from individual and relay swims
- **Top Country Club** – country club with the most points from individual and relay swims
- **Handicap** – club with the highest points per swimmer
