1.4 Board & Committee reports

Siobhan Tyndall provided an overview of the Boards activities to date:

- Annual 5 hr planning day Saturday 13th of January operational focus supporting new staff
- Board meeting 13th of March governance requirements for the year, preparation for AGM, discussed some brand direction/opportunities and reviewed organisational activities from the start of the year (Mullaloo mile, audit, AGM, upcoming state championships and grant opportunities/requirements).
- Office update staff resourcing/ hours vs workload. Siobhan Tyndall thanked clubs of their support of the new office staff and reminded the group that the Communications Events Coordinator role

2 Items for Discussion

2.1 Award nominations and awards night

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- Award night moved to better fit with calendar and allow new staff to catch up on workload from unstaffed office period in December 2023.
- Venue and date TBC but likely around July at a new venue that is more accessible.
- Some awards have been included in Annual report as constitution and bylaws demanded, these will be celebrated formally at the awards night.

- Coach of the year vs coach excellence award naming to be looked at as Bylaws wording different to nationally terminology.
- 2.2 Funding obligations and objectives
- RK thanked state officials, board members and clubs for workload supporting the office team to get settled in the role.
- A breakdown of MSWA funding was highlighted to attendees DLGSC, Healthway (ABC) and membership.
- Healthway new strategy 2024-2029 whole of population approach but priority populations:
 - Children and young people
 - Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders
 - > CALD
 - LGBTQIA+
 - Rural and remote
 - Disadvantage

Health issues/ focus areas:

- Promote healthy weight
- Reduce e-cigarette and tobacco use
- Improve mental, social and emotional wellbeing
- Increase physical activity
- Prevent harm from alcohol
- Currently have funding for ABC promotion, CALD come and try, younger demographic promotion and mental health champion network.

Healthway has indicated that future funding is not guaranteed and that MSWA will need to work within priority areas and populations to secure ongoing support. MSWA will promote mental health resources and initiatives to help achieve this.

- DLGSC funding remains ongoing with the office to meet governance requirements to ensure continued funding. Recategorization will occur in 2025 to assess the level and amount of funding provided to MSWA. Healthway funding, governance requirements and a constitution review will be critical to achieve his.
- An DLGSC coaching grant has been applied for with the outcome to be determined in April 2024 If successful this will allow MSWA to run 5 programs, 4 pool clinics and coaching conference.
